Gender-based violence in the domestic sphere

Domestic violence against women and girls is a massive problem. Not only because the annual number of victims is high, but also because the impact on the victims is enormous.





15.200 victims

Every year, around 15,200 women (aged 18 and older) in the Netherlands are victims of violence by a partner or ex-partner that occurs monthly, weekly or even daily.

- of all women in the Netherlands have ever been physically abused by a (former) partner
- 11% of all women in the Netherlands experience sexual violence by a (former) partner.
 - of all women in the Netherlands have shunned their own home for fear of violence.
- **25%** of all women in the Netherlands have ever experienced stalking.

The intervention

My New Future is the only gender-sensitive intervention in the Netherlands that specifically focuses on labour market participation and prospects of economic independence for women who have experienced domestic violence. The intervention consists of a three-month group training together with peers, coupled with a nine-month period of intensive personal counselling by a female volunteer coach.

- Intensive coaching by a female volunteer
- Custom made Personal Development Plan

The result

The women who have participated in My New Future are making great strides in gaining self-esteem and independence. A large proportion find jobs or have started training.



87% of participants grow steps on the *Self-Efficacy Matrix* in the domains of *Work & Education* or *Social Participation*


